What is CAHPS?

- Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (CAHPS) Program
 - Funded primarily by the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ)
 - Develops standardized surveys and related products, including the CAHPS Database
- CAHPS Surveys
 - Assess patients' experiences with care
 - Developed for both ambulatory and facility-based care



Core CAHPS Design Principles

- Focus on topics for which consumers are the best or only source of information
- Include patient reports and ratings of experiences – not "satisfaction"
- Base question items and survey protocols on rigorous scientific development and testing, as well as extensive stakeholder input
- All surveys and services are in the public domain

- Children's Health Insurance Reauthorization Act of 2009 (CHIPRA)
- AHRQ and CMS (Medicaid)
- CHIPRA Pediatric Quality Measures Program
 - Identification of core measure set for voluntary use by Medicaid and SCHIP programs
 - Development of new measures
 - CHIPRA Pediatric Quality Measures Centers of Excellence
