AHRR Hospital Readmissions for Psychiatric Conditions

Hospital readmissions for psychiatric conditions, which are costly and disruptive to individuals and families, can result from a worsening condition or ineffective care. This infographic shows that patients with schizophrenia or mood disorders, such as depression or bipolar disorder, were more likely in 2012 to be readmitted than patients with non-mental health conditions. Patients with schizophrenia or mood disorders were also less likely than others to receive home health care after initial discharge.
