- Do not forget to clean wounds! Cleaning wounds prevents surface bacteria from entering the body and causing infection.
- Clean ALL wounds unless deep or packed. Be sure to clean superficial wounds, closed surgical incisions, stage 1 and 2 decubitus ulcers, friable skin/rashes, and superficial burns.
- > CHG should be applied over any semipermeable or occlusive dressing.
- > Patients feel uncomfortable cleaning their wounds. Staff HAVE TO HELP clean them.
- > Staff: Use a clean CHG cloth to clean patient's wounds after showering.
